Session 1 | J.S. Bach and the German polyphonic tradition (organ, clavichord & voice) from 4 to 8 July, in collaboration with the Queen Elisabeth Music Chapel

- Organ works (manualiter) of Scheidemann, Buxtehude, Bach on the historic Goltfuss organ (1692) at the St. John-Baptist Church (Grand Béguinage)
- Bach organ works from Leipzig: Trio sonatas, Schübler Chorales, Preludes and Fugues on the Contius organ at the St. Michael's Church and the organ at the St. Gertrude Church
- J.S. Bach and C.P.E. Bach Arias, works by Buxtehude

- Six sonatas of C.P.E. Bach at the St. Gertrude Church
- Organ works of J.S. Bach and sons at the St. Michael's Church
- Works for clavichord of Bach and family

Teachers: Annette Richards (organ), Bernard Foccroulle (organ), Miklos Spanyi (organ & clavichord), Wim Winters (organ & clavichord)

Final concert: Friday July 12 at 20.30 at the St. Michael's Church
